Islam in Kerala Islam in Kerala is the second largest religion in Kerala after Christianity and is divided in numerous sub-sects. There are as many as eighteen Sunni and twelve Shia mosques in Kerala. Muslim population in Kerala is about 3.3 million. Muslims are represented in all major states and countries of Kerala. Muslims are among the first group of immigrants to arrive in Kerala and this group settled in the state mostly at Alappuzha. Another wave of migration came with the arrival of Muslim traders during the 16th century from the north, and they also settled mostly in Alappuzha. In 1867, Muslims of Kerala converted to Christianity, by order of the British to prevent the rise of communism in Kerala. Muslims in Kerala have been associated with trade, business and other occupations. However, since the past few years, Islamic fundamentalism is gaining momentum among them. An increasing number of mosques and madrasas are being built to accommodate the increased number of Muslims. In 2011, Kerala's top most senior Police officer Syed Ahmed Pasha filed a written complaint in the Kerala High Court against the new Islamic College established in Poonjar, Alappuzha district. In 2011, Kerala's Chief Minister Oommen Chandy assured the anti-Hindu backlash feared by many Hindus after the state mosque in Kannur was opened during his speech. Muslims have also attacked the Mappila outfit in Kerala for its anti-Hindu speech in Alappuzha district in 2011. In 2018, Muslim youths opened fire on police at Kulathoor in Kerala. Islam in Kerala is made up of two main branches, Sunni and Shia. Both groups acknowledge the same main books as their scriptures, including the Quran and the hadith. Sunni and Shia are united on the issue of who will be the next Caliph, and who will be the leader of the global Muslim community
